ENTRY INFORMATION FOR ST BARTHS

The official France Visas website offers the "Do I need a visa?" tool that allows everyone to check if they need to apply for a visa before entering St Barths:

Do I need a visa?

When a visa is required, the visa application must be completed online, before departure, on the official France Visas website:

France Visas

No tourist visas will be issued on site, at the border, or at the prefecture.

Schengen short-stay visas are not valid in St Barths and Sint-Marteen as both islands are not part of the Schengen area.

The only accepted short-stay visas are national visas with one of the following mentions: "France except CTOM"; "French Departments of America"; "Collectivity of Saint-Barthélemy" or "Collectivity of Saint-Martin," depending on the island concerned.

The United States permanent resident card (known as the "green card") is not a document that allows entry into French territory.

Holders of these cards must refer to the entry conditions applicable to their nationality.

Customers entering Sint-Marteen through Princess Juliana International Airport must also comply with the entry rules for the Dutch part of Sint-Marteen.

Travelers must fill out the entry and exit form no more than 7 days before and at least 2 hours before their trip.
